The School of Management is now equipped with a fully functional production studio. The studio features 2 digital cameras, professional lighting, broadcast quality microphone, and acoustic sound treatment. The adjoining control room offers a 1.2 terabyte server to house recorded audio-visual materials.

This facility is ideal for producing course materials to be delivered via the Internet, as well as in the traditional classroom. Examples of course materials that can be produced include streamed lectures, panel discussions, clips from publisher videos, copyrighted media, "virtual chalkboard" sessions, software tutorials, web-friendly PowerPoint Presentations with synchronized audio, and much more. No technical expertise beyond basic PC skills is required on the part of the faculty member. The studio is available Monday through Friday 8:30-5:30.
